Thank you for your interest in being a part of the Scottish Tartan Festival. The festival is an annual event each year in Minden, Louisiana. The location for the 2023 festival is Miller Quarter, 198 Gleason St., Minden, LA (next to the Civic Center in Minden).

1. Both copies of the application must be signed and returned with payment no later than April 17, 2023. Please keep a copy for your own records.
2. An accepted application is a commitment to the festival, therefore no vendor fees are refunded for cancellations, or inclement weather. The festival will take place rain or shine unless otherwise notified.
3. Vendors may set-up their booths on Friday from noon to 8 PM, or on Saturday morning beginning at 7:00 AM. Please be ready by 9:00 AM. Please bring your own tent, tables, chairs, etc. as none are provided by the festival. It is highly recommended that you make sure you have sufficient weights to secure your tent since it has been known to get a little windy at times. **No cars will be allowed on the grounds (after set up) for the protection of the festival patrons.**
4. Food vendors must be in compliance with the La. Dept. of Health and Hospitals and supply us with a Certificate of Liability from your insurance.
5. Spaces are limited and will be assigned on a first come basis but we will make sure that like merchandise are not set up next to each other.
6. This is a family event, so please keep this in mind when displaying items you have for sell. We reserve the right to have you remove any merchandise we deem inappropriate.
7. Pets are welcome on the grounds provided they remain leashed. Animal wastes are your responsibility. And all pets must have up-to-date rabies shot tags.
